WELCOME

Founded in 2004, the New American Youth Ballet is a non-profit organization committed to providing classical ballet training to students of all ages. NAYB is divided into two tracks of study: Community classes and the Training Program. Community classes are open to any child or adult, ages three and up. The Training Program is by audition only.

ENROLLMENT

Admission to NAYB's community classes is open to all students with a desire to dance. Level placement in the community classes is based primarily on age (particularly for continuing NAYB students). New students ages 8 and up will need to be evaluated for proper level placement and may be placed in a lower level until they have caught up with their age group. All classes are restricted to 10 students. A wait list will be formed once a class has filled.

SCHEDULE

Community classes are held in two semesters: Fall and Winter. Each semester includes ten weeks of instruction with a mini performance recital on Saturday of the eleventh week.

OBSERVATION

Observation of classes is not permitted. Parents have a chance to see what their child has been learning at the end of semester performance.

PERFORMANCE

A mini performance is held on the eleventh week of each semester. Each class will perform a few classroom exercises and a short dance prepared especially for the event. The performance is held at the New American Youth Ballet studios and is offered free of charge for family and friends. In addition, students enrolled in the Fall Semester will have an opportunity to audition for a role in the Nutcracker, performed on stage in December, and students enrolled in the Winter Semester will have an opportunity to audition for a role in our Spring Ballet, performed in April.

FEMALE STUDENT DRESS CODE

Female students must wear pink tights, pink ballet slippers and a black ballet leotard. Skirts and tutus are not permitted. All female students must wear long hair in a ballet bun or pull short hair off the face. Dress code items can be found in most major stores (Walmart, Target, etc) or can be purchased at Standing Ovation Performance Apparel on Coliseum Blvd.

MALE STUDENT DRESS CODE

Male students must wear black basketball style athletic shorts, white plain t-shirt, white socks and black or white ballet shoes. Ballet shoes can be found in most major stores (Walmart, Target, etc) or can be purchased at Standing Ovation Performance Apparel on Coliseum Blvd.

TUITION

Tuition must be paid in full to reserve a spot in the class. Tuition should be paid in cash or by check and must be submitted with the enrollment form on the back of this brochure. Tuition is non-refundable.
